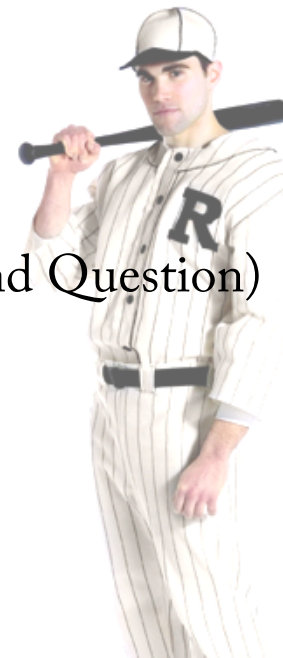

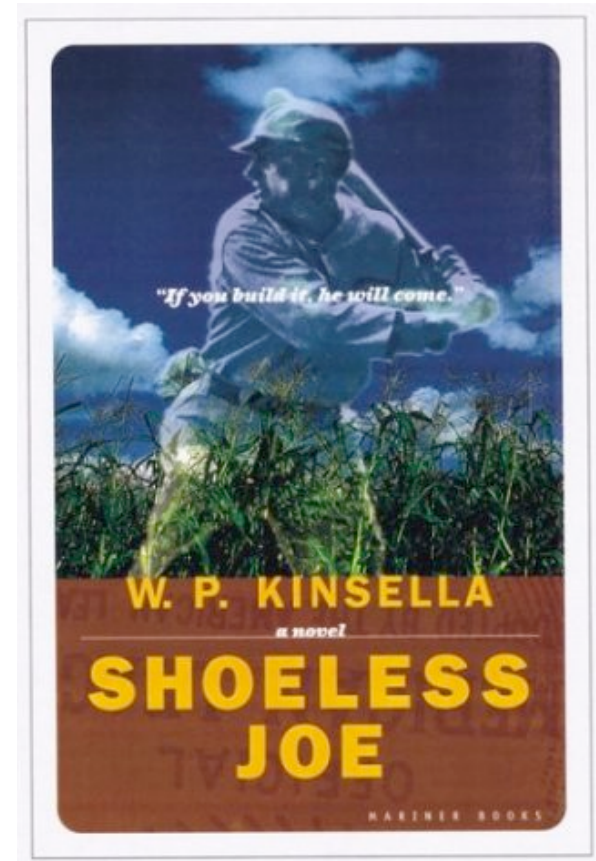
Ray:
