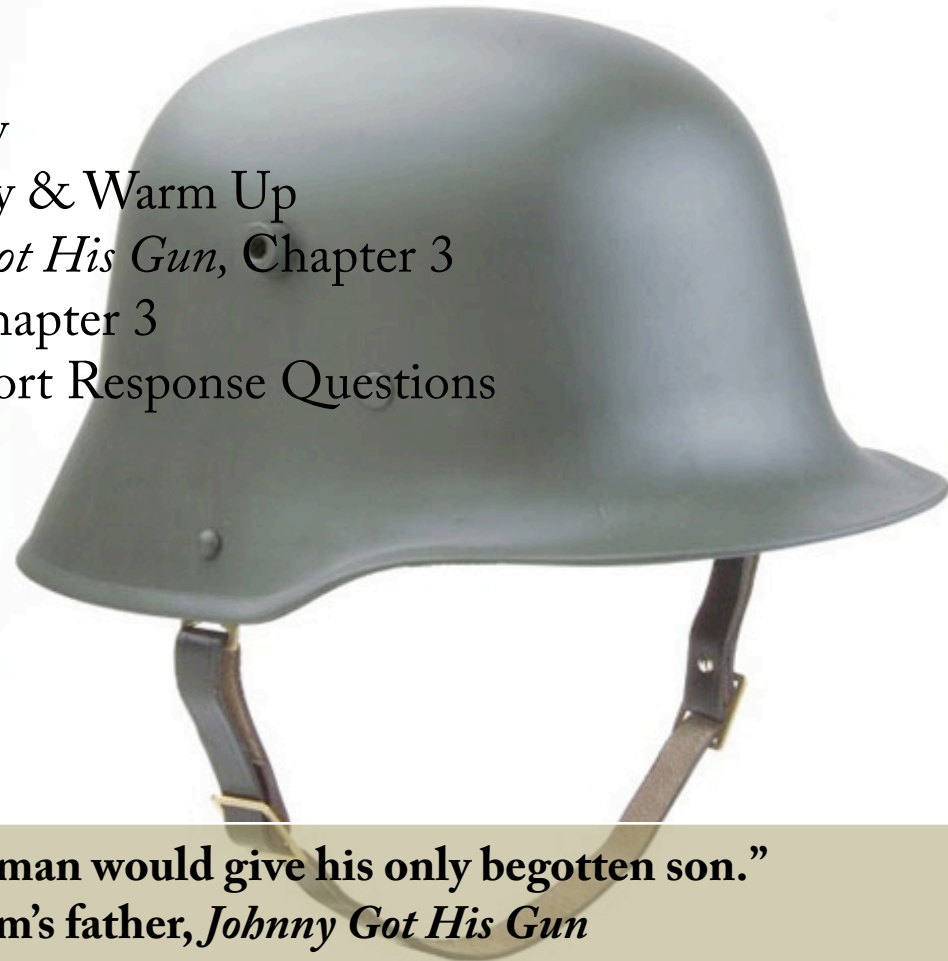

## T A K E N O T E S

### Major Characters:

- Joe Bonham: main character; the narrator
- Kareen: Joe's girlfriend
- Joe's father
- The Nurse(s)

# *Johnny Got His Gun*

## Setting:

- Reality: The hospital in Europe (whole novel)
  - But, Joe's memories takes us anywhere.

# *Johnny Got His Gun*

## Flashback:

- Going back to a previous event in time

# *Johnny Got His Gun*

## Unreliable Narrator:

- When the narrator (the one telling the story) cannot be trusted— happens by lying or omission.



# *Johnny Got His Gun*

## Chapter 3 (Hospital)

- Joe's left arm is amputated (cut off). He then remembers the wedding ring on it. He has a flashback to his last night with Kareen (girlfriend) before the joining the war. He loses both of his arms.
