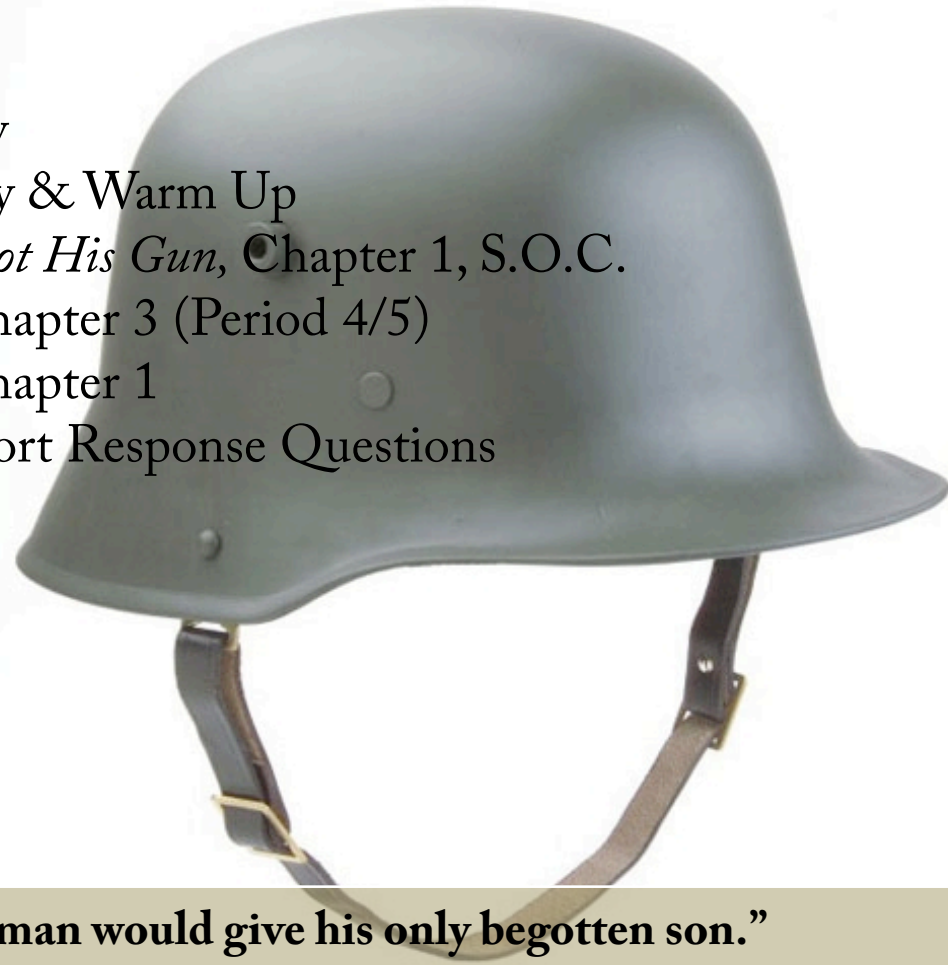

## Chapter 1

- Joe hears a phone ringing. This leads to a flashback about him getting a phone call about his father's death when he was a teenager. Joe realizes that he is sick and is going in and out of consciousness.
