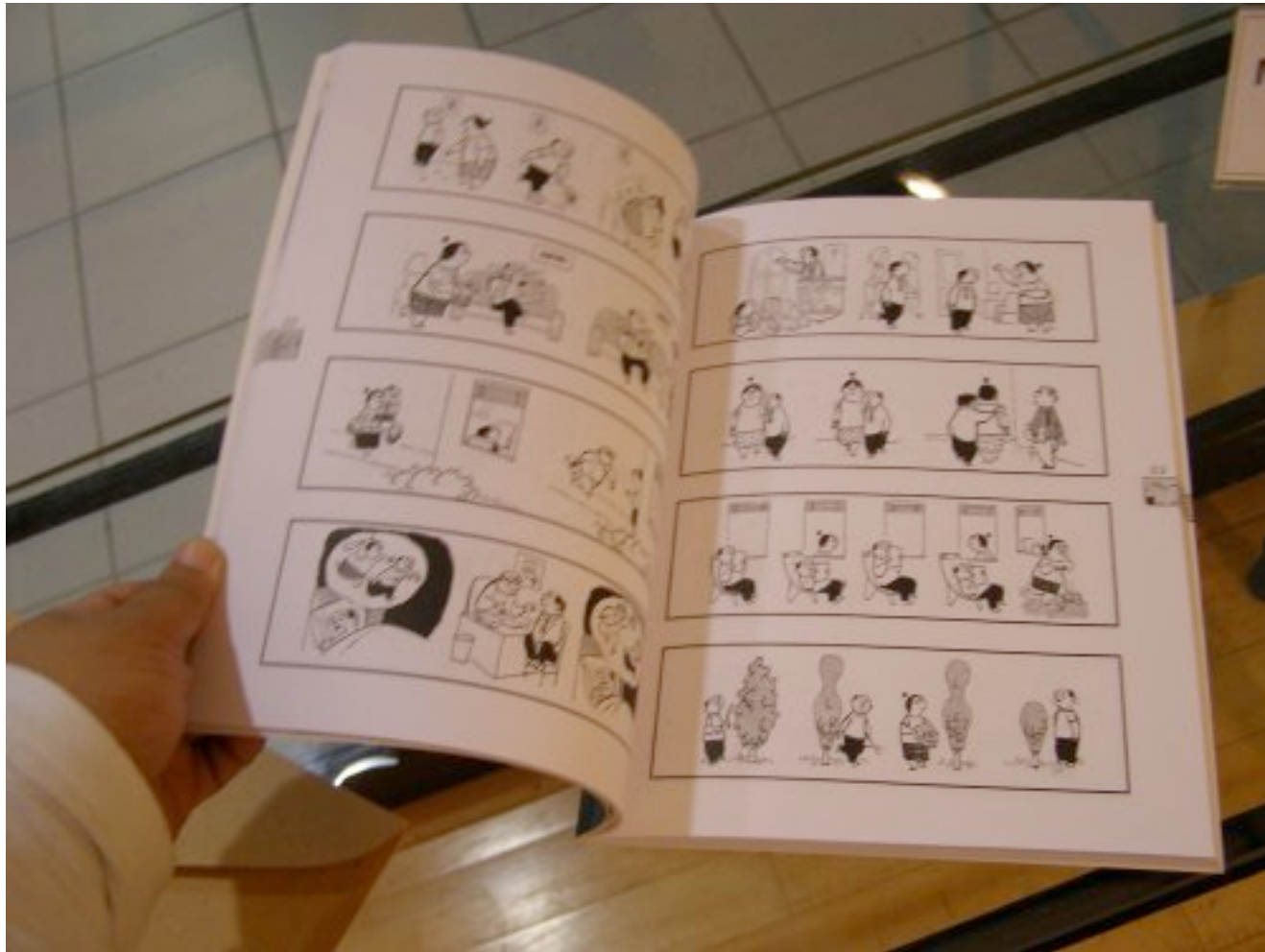

- Graded based on how accurate your drawing is compared to the actual scene.

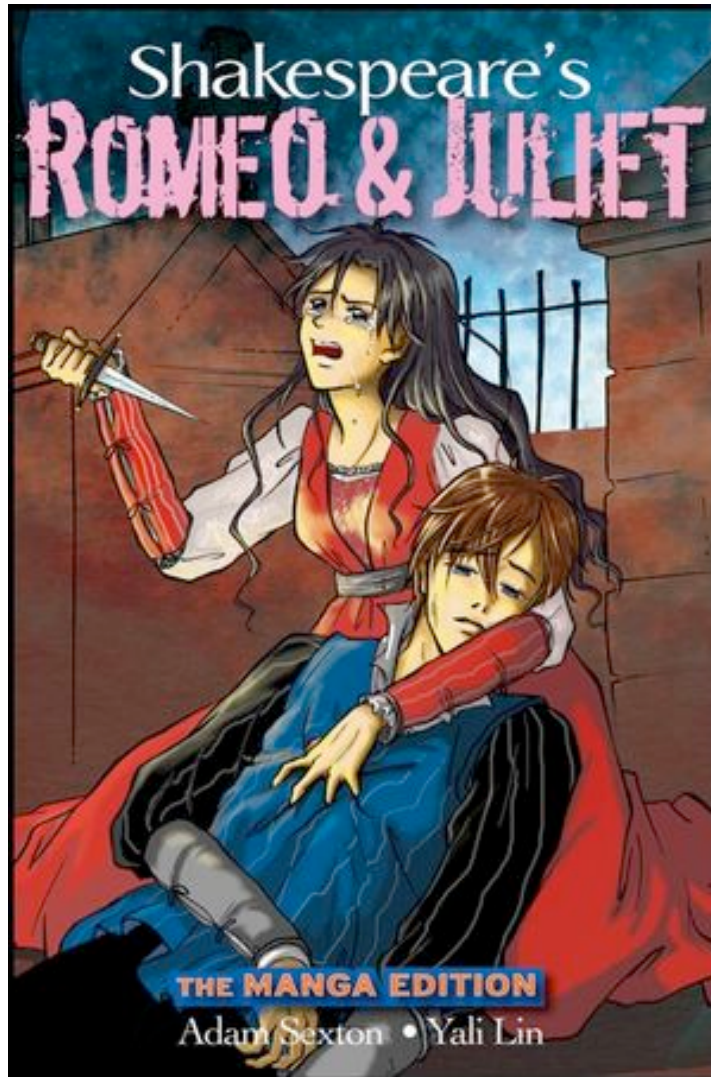

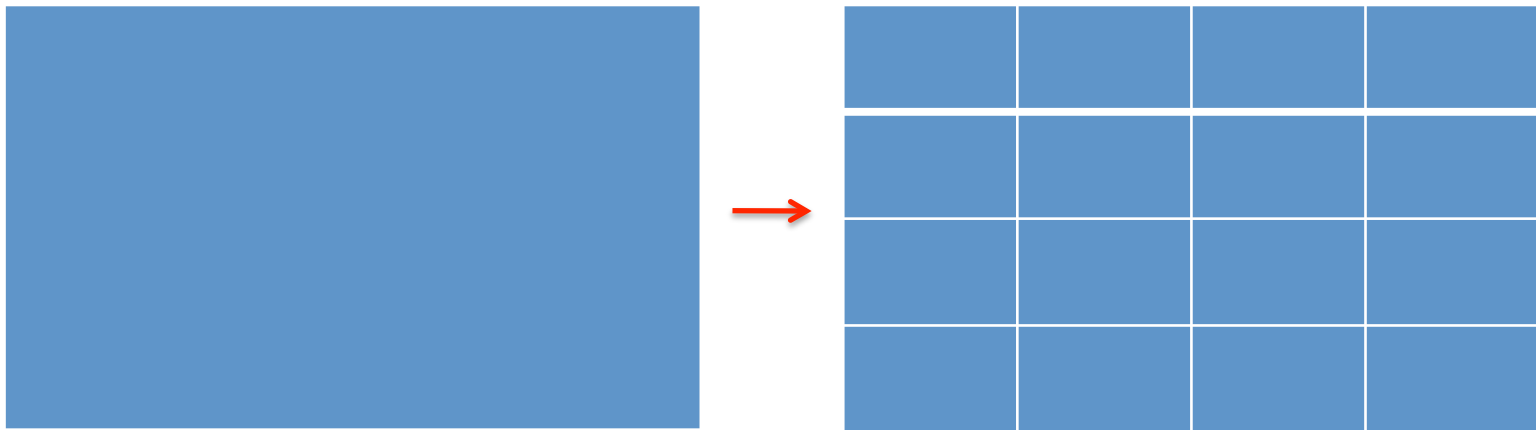
