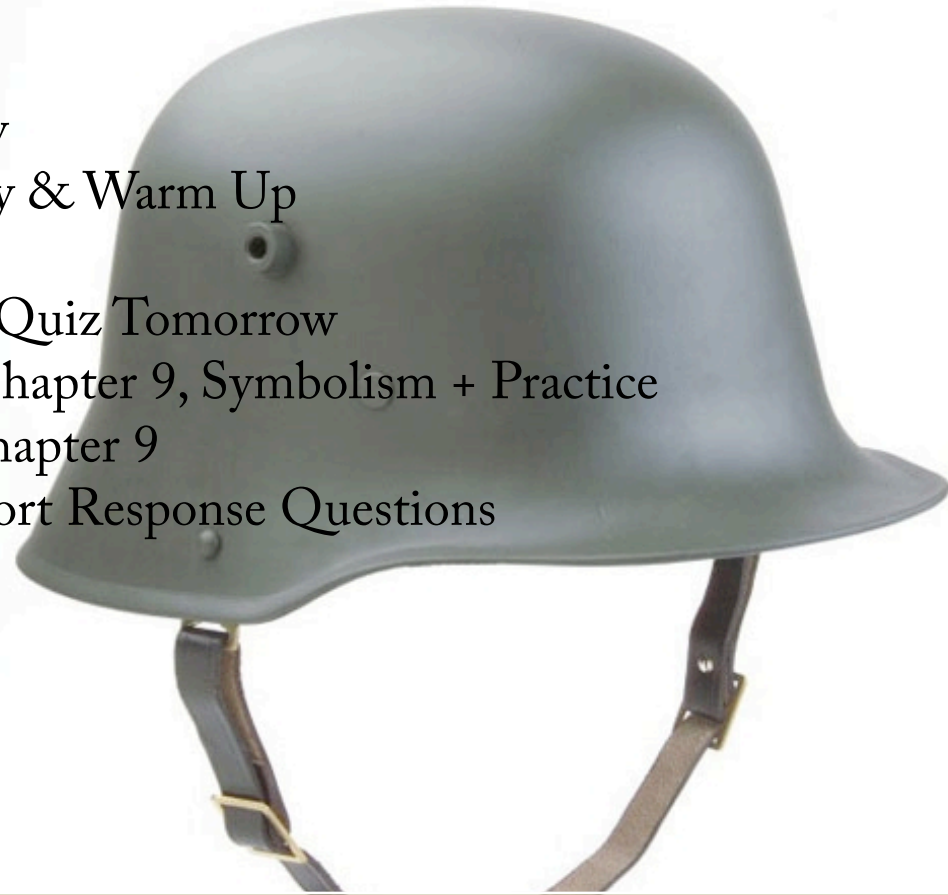

## Chapter 7 (“The Rat”)

# Symbolism

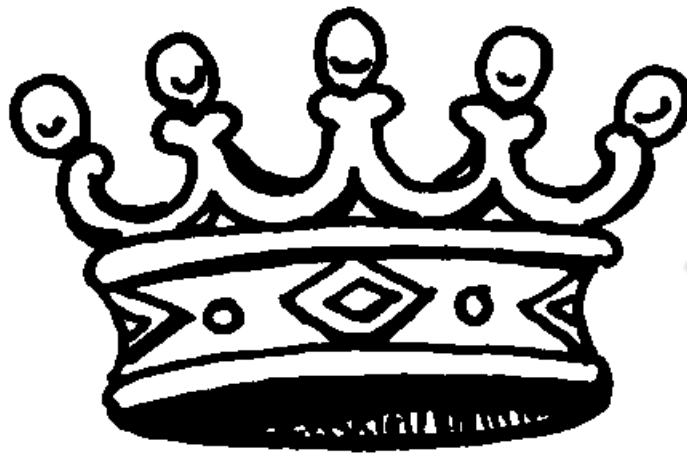
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- A person, place, object, or event that stands for itself as well as something *beyond* itself (a metaphorical meaning)
