





 - "Witches Hammer"
 - Latin text
 - Written 1486
 - About recognizing and combating witchcraft.

MALLEVS MALEFICA-RVM, MALEFIS cas, & earum hærefim, vt ... phramea potentifsima conterens.

<u>Mr. Hale's Personal Library</u>

- Malleus Maleficarum
 - Section I: The devil exists and he gives power to the witch
 - Section II: The powers of the witch (stealing men's "manhood," infanticide, evil spells)
 - Section III: How to put a witch on trial



Latin Usage

- Latin Vulgate Bible = 5thcentury A.D.
 - Dead language, but in modern books and movies, the Latin text seems to contain some power over the supernatural.
- Hale, Act I: "In nomine Domine Sabaoth sui filiique ite ad infernos"
 - In the name of the Lord and his son, go to hell.



- 13 Ghosts
 - Glass panels that contain Latin phrases are used to keep ghosts out of certain rooms.

Formulae ueteres exorsismorum et excommunicationum Strigas et fictos lupinam credere Metamorphosis lycanthropy Possunt inquam Daemon pellem lupinam

English:

Ancient formulas of exorcisms and excommunications That witches and those made Wolves Believe I am now The demon clothed in wolf skin
