

Elie Wiesel


- Born 1928
- Lived in Sighet, Romania until 1944.
 - Deported along with family to a concentration camp.
 - Camp liberated in 1945
 - Wiesel survived; others did not
 - Wrote Night in 1958





Night

- Tells Wiesel's story of the Holocaust.
 - Ch. 1 = Before German occupation.
 - Ch. 2-8 = Deportation and Concentration Camp Life
 - Ch. 9 = Camp is liberated




SLM Vocabulary

- Beadle = a Jewish religious official
- Zionism = a movement to establish a Jewish state
- Fascist / Fascism = a government led by a dictator
- Passover = a Jewish holiday
- Ghetto = a section set up to keep the Jews
- Pentecost = a religious holiday (Christian and Jewish)
- Talmud = Jewish religious texts
