PSAT Information



- The PSAT (Pre-SAT) is a college-readiness exam.
- It tests Reading, Math, and Writing skills.
- It is NOT for a grade in this class.
- It is NOT a graduation requirement.

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PSAT Tips



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- Questions go from EASY to DIFFICULT.
 - 1, 2, 3 = Easy
 - 8, 9, 10 = Difficult
- Correct answers are worth 1 point.
- Incorrect answers subtract $\frac{1}{4}$ a point.
 - Choose answers you know are correct, or if you can eliminate 1 or 2 answer choices.
 - If you have no idea, do not guess.
