Dictionary



- Used to look up the meaning of words you want to know

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Thesaurus



- Used to look up synonyms (same meaning) and antonyms (opposite meaning) of words.

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Atlas



- A collection of maps—usually of the Earth, but sometimes space.



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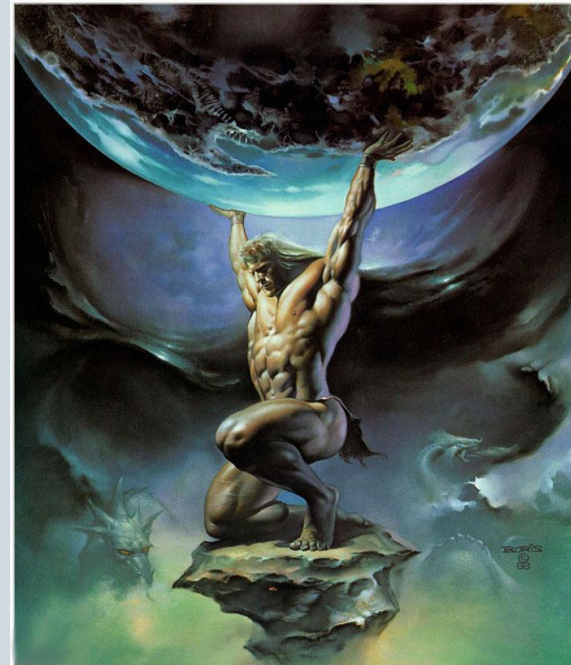
Atlas



- “Atlas” comes from the Greek titan who was forced to hold up the world as punishment

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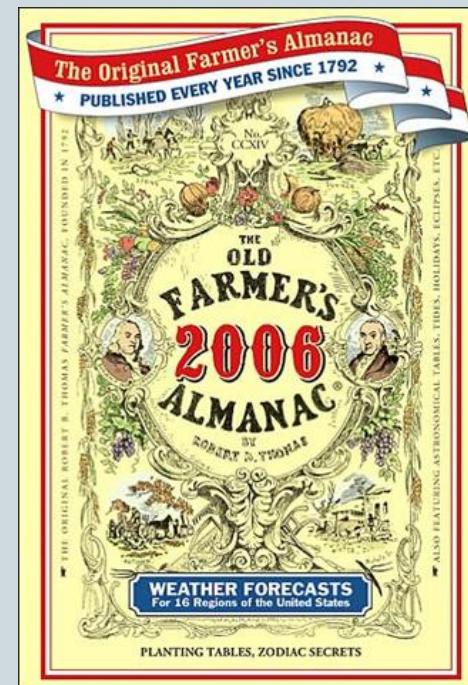
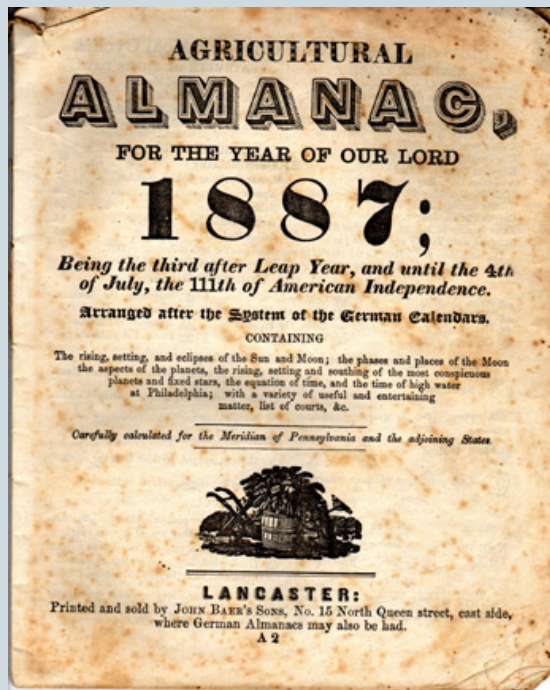
Almanac



- An annual publication containing information related to farming (sometimes government, religion, etc.) and weather forecasts

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Newspaper



- A daily publication containing information about business, crime, entertainment, sports, editorials, and usually advertising.



Magazine/Periodical



T A K E N O T E S

- A monthly publication containing information about a special interest:
 - Pets
 - Technology
 - Gaming
 - Etc.

Encyclopedia



- A collection of articles on all branches or a specific branch of knowledge.
- Comes from the Greek word for “general knowledge.”



Internet



T A K E N O T E S

- The internet is a collection of databases held online in servers across the world.
- It can be any/all of the previous listed resources
 - Dictionaries, Encyclopedia, etc.
- Includes chat rooms, blogs, Wikipedia, etc.
