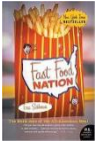

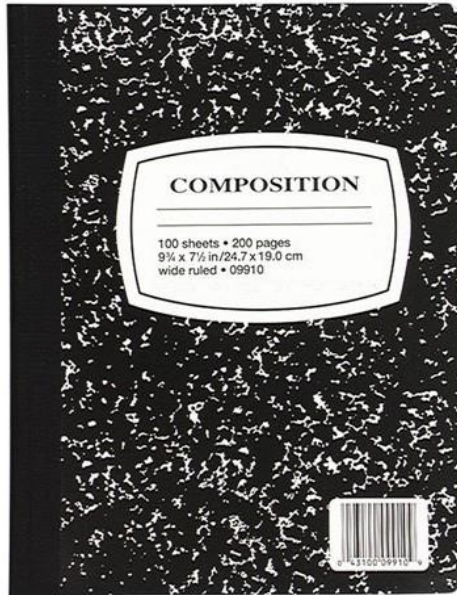

FCAT

- 2001-2011
- Paper-based
- Custom-made passages specifically for test
- Read one passage, answer questions
- Lower text complexity
- Lower-end passing score

FCAT 2.0

- 2012-2013
- Computer-based
- Passages from Public Domain (non-copyright)
- Read two passages; questions about both passages
- Higher text complexity
- Higher-end passing score

Preparing for FCAT

T A K E N O T E S

- Look over your notes (elements of fiction, persuasion, etc.)
- Make flash cards and study your POETRY TERMS
