



Common GP Question Threads

Thesis Statement (on essays)

Definition:

- ☐ Roadmap for paper
- ☐ Makes a claim for discussion
- ☐ Usually 1-2 sentences
- ☐ Comes after your introduction sentences

Checklist for a STRONG thesis:

- ☐ Answer the question being asked
- ☐ Take a position (be specific!)
- ☐ Passes the "so what?" test (makes reader care about your subject)

Weak vs. Strong Thesis Statements

Section 3, Prompt 15 (Impact of Television)

- "Television is fun." → WEAK
- "Television teaches me about the world" → WEAK
- "Over the past fifty years, television has impacted the way in which we see the world and the ways we interact with each other." → STRONG

Weak vs. Strong Thesis Statements

Section 2, Prompt 7 (Cyber Crime)

- "The internet is a dangerous place." → WEAK
- "The internet has allowed a whole new type of criminal to emerge. This criminal is capable of not only stealing your money, but also stealing the identity that makes you unique." → STRONG
