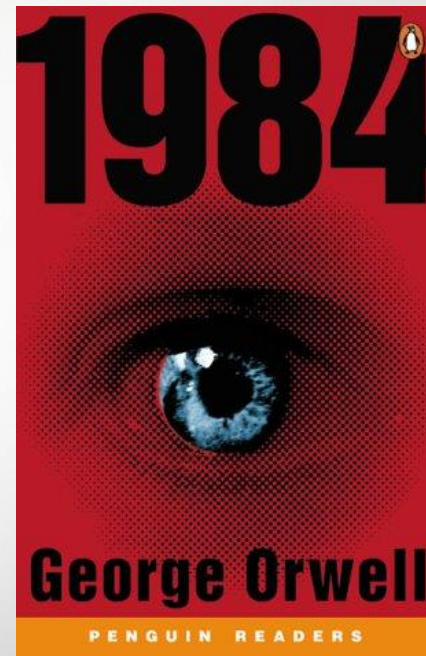

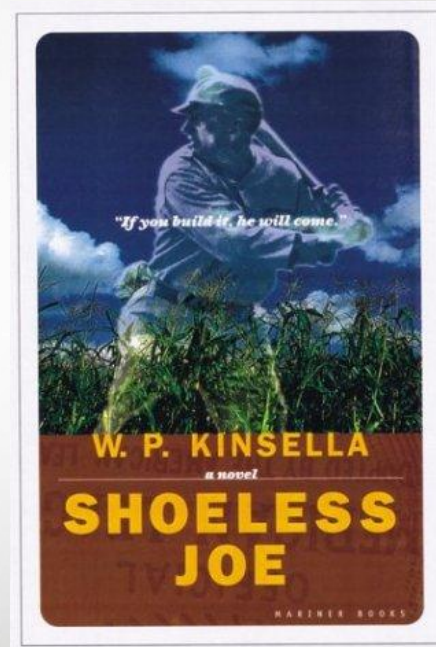
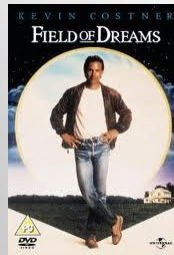
- ❖ *1984*, Orwell

from



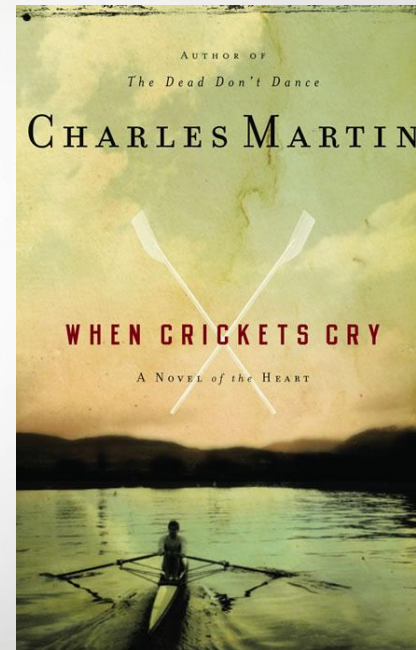
CHOICES

Dreams (If you build it, he will come)



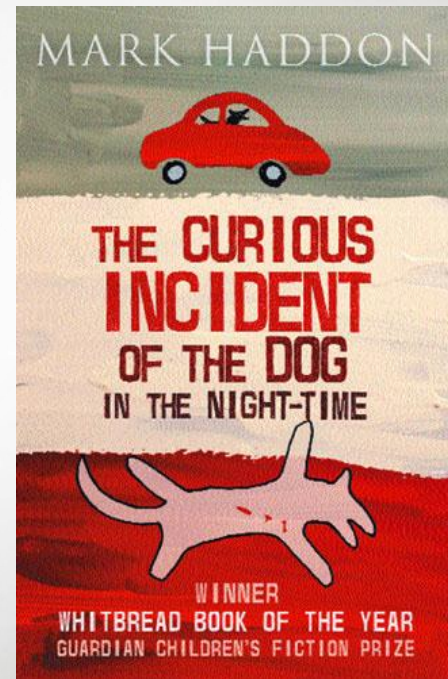
CHOICES

- ❖ Most highly rated book last year



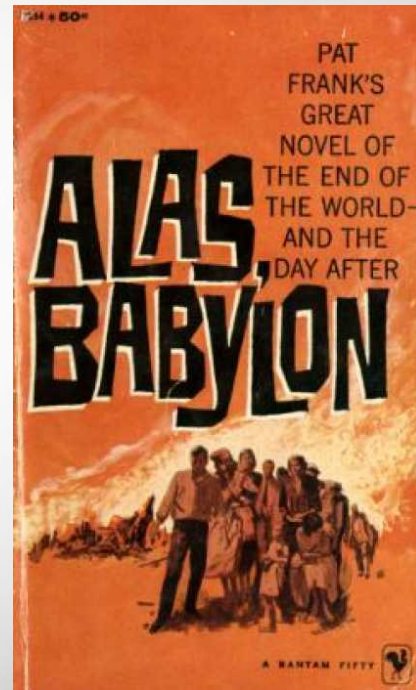
CHOICES

- ❖ Easiest to read



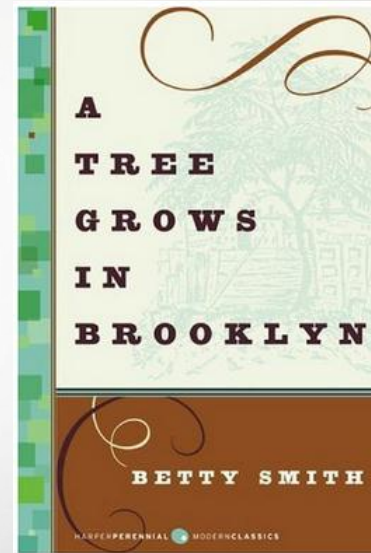
CHOICES

- ❖ Follows Frances Nolan through her life: poverty, family, love, etc.

- ❖ *To Kill a Mockingbird*, Lee
