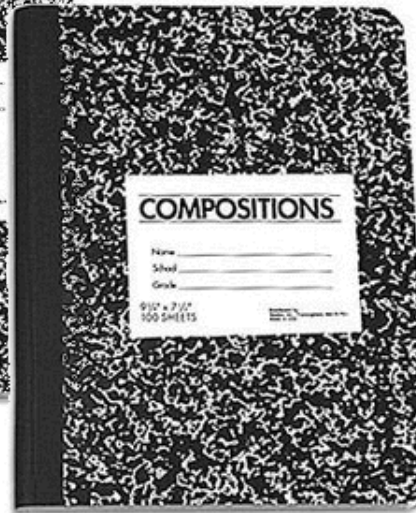
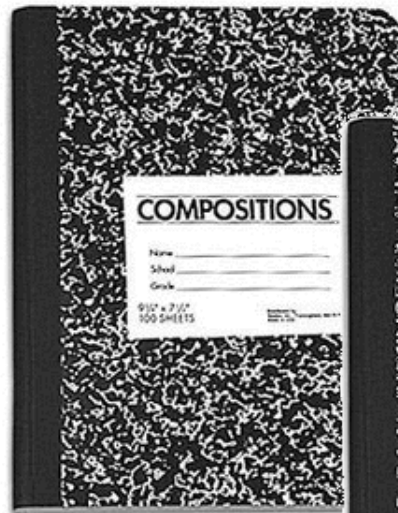

# Voices from the Past (c/o 2013)

## Survey done last year:

- “I learned more in Language than in General Paper”
  - 72% Agree / 27% about the same / 1% less
- “I found my junior year to be *much* harder than my sophomore year”
  - 97% Agree / 3% about the same
- “If I could offer any advice to incoming Juniors taking AICE Language, I would like to tell them...”

# Voices from the Past (c/o 2013)

- “Prepare to die...if you think that you can pass just by going to class, expect to get a D or worse.”
- “Absences killed my grade...if you’re absent, get the make up work as soon as you can. I missed a week and by the time I got back, we were on something completely new.”
- “Hampton’s assignments really don’t make any sense...one day you’ll go outside to describe a rock or a tree and think this isn’t helping you...then 6 months later when you’re taking your exam and it asks you to describe a rock, you’ll quietly smile to yourself.
