Colon vs. Semi-Colon

- Mary ate dinner; the dinner was delicious. OR
- Mary ate dinner: the dinner was delicious.
- Semi-Colon...used to join two complete sentences
 - Sentences must be connected in some way
 - Also used with *however* or *for example*
- Colon...used to list or to further explain
 - Also used with *titles, subtitles, hours/minutes, formal letters*

whoa, stop! STOP!!!
that's a colon, not
a semi-colon!
