Day 10 (Monday, 11.12.12)


Please have **one person read aloud** (Volume-0: 3) the following to your team:

Welcome to your tenth day of reading and discussing your team-selected novels! Today's activity is quite unique, as you will be combining (or "mashing up") with another team who is reading a different book from your team. You will not be grading each other today.

Please have **another person read aloud** (Volume-0: 3) the following to your team:

The "Activity":

- 1. 2 minutes: Are there any absent members of your team? If so, make arrangements to contact them (email, text, or phone call) to explain what they missed today.
- 2. 3 minutes: Have everyone in all teams make a **Venn-Diagram** in their notebooks. On one side, put the title of your book; on the other, leave it blank.



- 3. 3 minutes: In **Volume-O: 1**, look at the front board. This will tell you what team you'll be "mashing up" with today. Volume-O is the hardest to maintain at this point, so be extra careful not to make much noise. You will want to bring your materials, your chairs, and/or your tables (QUIETLY!) Please move now.
- 4. 15-20 minutes: Your goal today is to find and list similarities and differences between your novel and the novel of the other team that's joined you today. Write the name of the book that joined you today on the other side of your diagram. Although your books were written by different authors in different time periods, you'd be surprised how much in common you can find. You must find 10-12 differences and 6-8 similarities. Remember to paraphrase and elaborate.
