

# Ender's Game: Movie Adaption Project

### Directions:

- □ Your group will make a **movie adaption** of your novel.
- □ Each person graded in their individual contribution:
  - □ TEAM: Needs to create a movie-poster of their adaption
  - □ TEAM: Come up with a list of actors / actresses, a rating (PG, PG-13, etc.), memorable scene(s) for your poster, 1-2 memorable quotes from the story. Poster must be in color and highly detailed.
  - □ TEAM: A 1-page explanation of why you chose those actors, ratings, etc. Staple this to back of poster.
  - □ EACH INDIVIDUAL: Select one scene from your book to show in your movie. Write a 1-2 page description of how that scene would be played out in your movie version. Include mention of what would be shown or not shown on screen; changes that you would make from the novel, etc.
