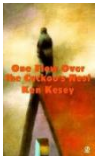

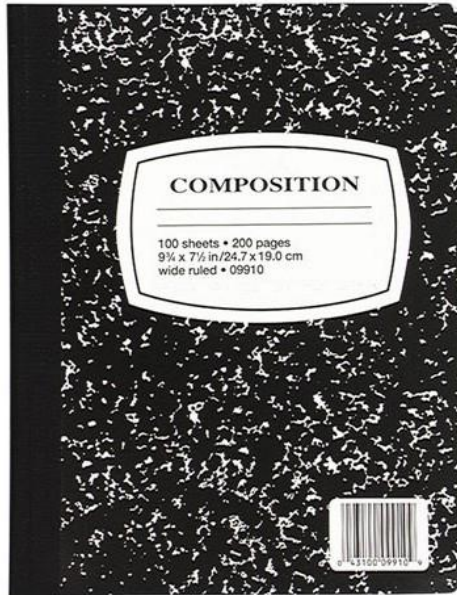

T A K E N O T E S

1. Ideas

- Did you cite?
- Is it explained adequately?

2. Organization

- Is paper formatted correctly (header, title, font, works cited page)

3. Voice

- Does your paper sound unique?
- Usually a product of 4-6

4. Word Choice

- Academic vocabulary?
- Do you “say what you mean”? (no idioms)

5. Sentence Fluency

- Incorrect tense shifting

6. Conventions

- Terrible spelling errors?
