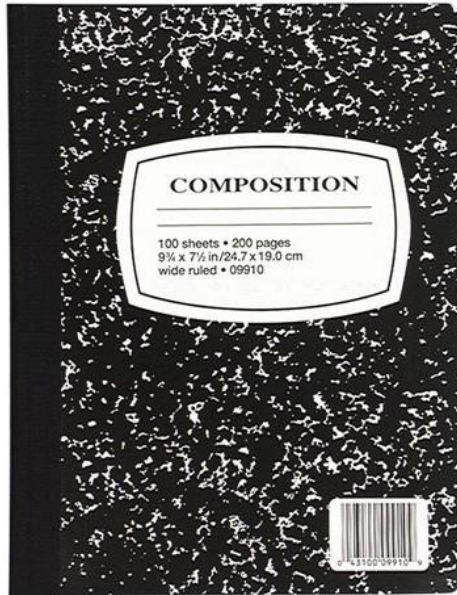
Team Builder: *Best Movie of 2012*

T A K E N O T E S

- Chief is (crazy) narrator; has been in ward several years; child-like; sees “fog”
- McMurphy is new inmate; transferred from work farm for “fighting and fucking too much”
- Nurse Ratched (“The Big Nurse”) controls ward
- Group therapy sessions not really group therapy
- Harding explains the “way of the Combine” to McMurphy; McMurphy claims that Nurse is “pecking at their everlovin’ balls”
- Patients claim Nurse can’t do anything to McMurphy unless he “cracks”; not entirely true → she can keep him in the ward
- McMurphy vows to be a “bee in her bloomers”
- McMurphy enters the Nurse’s station w/o permission (symbolism?)
- Chief lets slip that he can hear McMurphy
