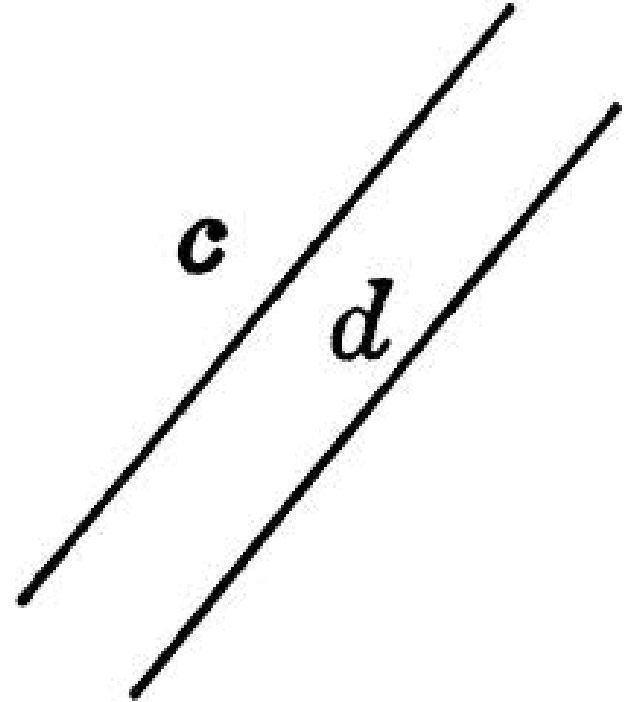

  - “Your company and its potential are of great value to me.”

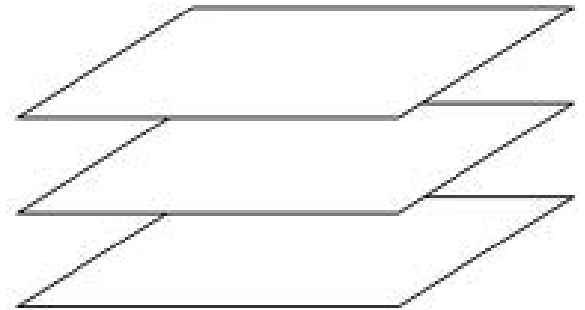


# Parallel Structure

## T A K E N O T E S

### When To Use Parallel Structure:

1. Elements joined by a conjunction
  - Your company and its potential are of great value
2. Elements are in a list or series
  - The tribes emphasized survival, mutual aid, and responsibility.
3. If elements are being compared
  - I like swimming more than diving.
4. If elements are joined by a linking verb
  - To succeed is to open a new opportunity.
