



Meatpacking


- Handles the slaughtering, processing, and distribution of livestock, such as:
 - Cattle
 - Pigs
 - Other animals
- Can yield by-products, such as hides (skin), feathers, beef tallow (previously used in French Fries)


Meatpacking

- Unsanitary conditions, unfair labor practices, until:
 - Upton Sinclair visited meatpacking plants in early 1900s, wrote about conditions in *The Jungle*
 - Wrote it to bring attention to unfair treatment of PEOPLE, but it instead gave rise to the FDA (Food and Drug Administration) in 1906
- Many workers are illegal aliens (Mexico is #1)



Kenny Dobbins

- Employee of Monfort (one of the largest meatpacking facilities in the US)
- Received numerous injuries from his job
- Shares a lot in common with Kenny from South Park; injured a lot, but somehow does not die
