## New Categories

$\square$ Categories will now reflect skills
$\square$ Old categories = quizzes, tests, participation, etc.
$\square$ New categories:

1. Grammar and Language 15\%
2. Writing and Research $35 \%$
3. Speaking and Listening $20 \%$
4. Reading $30 \%$
$\square$ WR will be transferred to "Reading"
$\square$ Categories = strengths and weaknesses

## Grades

$\square$ Only 4 grades for most assignments:
