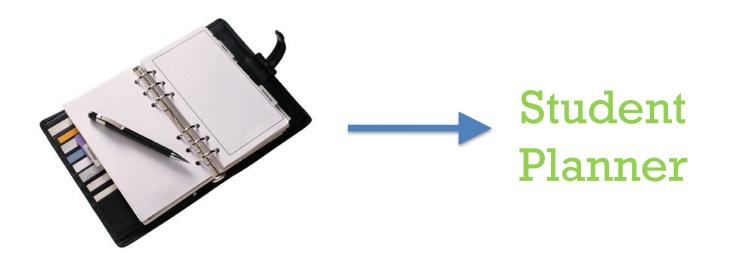




Language Analysis Checklist
