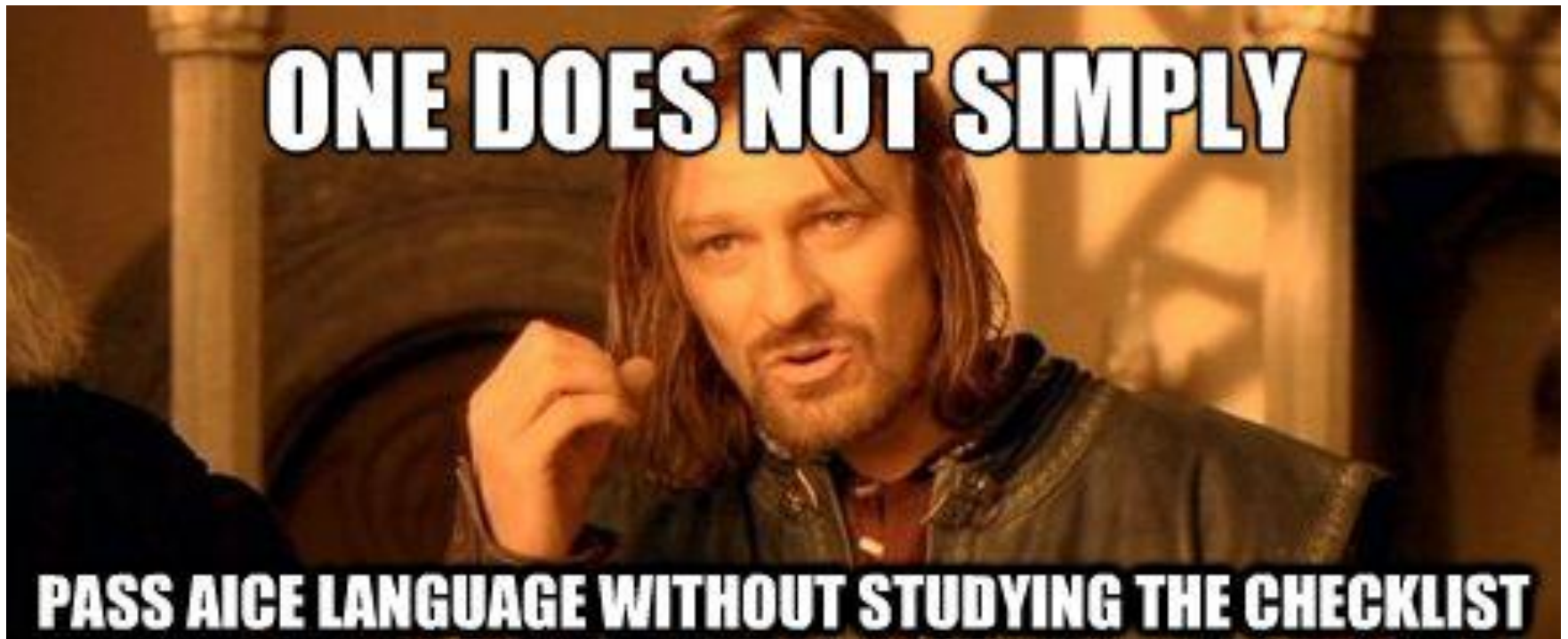
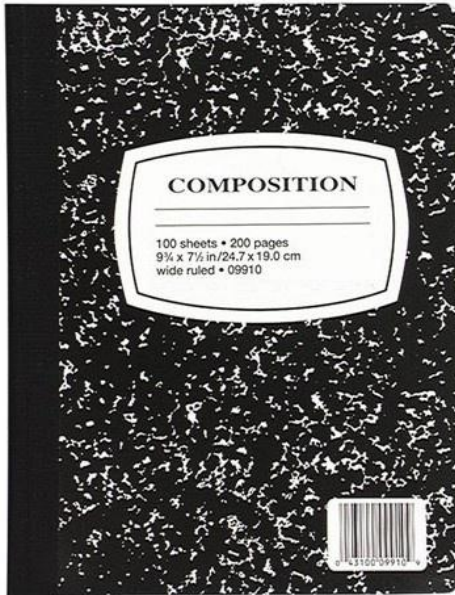

# Language Analysis Checklist

## T A K E N O T E S

- Review over notes on **Language Analysis / Return to L..A.**
