

- Most complex skill to learn
- Takes years to master
- Careers within magazine companies dedicated to realistic skin clean up
- Don't be surprised if you don't "get it" immediately
- WARNING: Do not remove permanent features from someone's face (freckle, mole, etc.) unless asked.

Simple Skin Clean Up

- 1. Use "healing brush" tool to clean up acne or discolorations
- 2. Use "eye dropper" tool → set to 31 x 31 average → sample skin area
- 3. Use "brush" tool \rightarrow set opacity to 20-30% \rightarrow paint on skin
- 4. Make sure to "Resample" area with eye dropper (hold ALT key) when going under new patch of skin

Complex Skin Clean Up (Part I)

- 1. Do Simple Skin Clean Up first!
- 2. Image \rightarrow Mode \rightarrow CMYK
- 3. Layers window \rightarrow Channels \rightarrow Click on Yellow channel
- 4. Copy yellow channel (Control A, Control C); undo (Control Z)
- 5. Paste yellow channel in layer window (Control V)
- 6. Invert layer (Control I)
- 7. Change blend mode → Soft Light

Complex Skin Clean Up (Part II)

- 1. Merge layers together into Smart object (Select all layers; right click; convert to Smart Object)
- 2. Duplicate layer (Control J)
- 3. Filter \rightarrow Blur \rightarrow Surface Blur
 - 1. Set threshold to 255 levels, adjust radius so you can barely see face
 - 2. Reduce threshold until you can see details in face; should still be blurry
 - 3. Hit okay
- 4. Go to original layer; duplicate layer (Control J); move this layer to the top of window
- 5. Filter \rightarrow Other \rightarrow High Pass
 - 1. Adjust radius so you can make out skin details
 - 2. Hit okay
- 6. Change blending mode on this layer to "hard light"

Complex Skin Clean Up (Part II)

- 7. Group all layers together (except original layer) -> Control G
- 8. Add inverted layer mask this group (ALT, layer mask button)
- 9. Set white "Brush" to 50% opacity and paint over areas to apply airbrush

Teeth Clean Up

- 1. Merge all layers (Layer → Merge visible)
- 2. Use "Lasso" or "Polygonal lasso" tools to highlight teeth
- 3. Select \rightarrow Modify \rightarrow Feather
- 4. Set to 3-5 pixels or larger if needed
- 5. "Dodge" tool \rightarrow set to Midtones \rightarrow exposure to 30%
- 6. Pass tool over teeth once; use multiple times if necessary
